

Common Eider - 65 flying off mouth of Savage Harbour, only 4 adult males, August 3 (BP)

Bald Eagle - the New Glasgow eagle moved its nest across the river. They had 2 chicks in early June (DW)

Ring-necked Pheasant - 1 female at New Annan, June 26 (JB)

Semipalmated Plover - 1 at Murray Islands, July 28 (GB)
 - 40 at Argyle Shore, July 29 (BC);
 - at St. Peter's Harbour 120 on August 10; 89 on August 14; 63 on August 17; 105 on August 22; and 172 on August 25 (BP)

Killdeer - 6 at Argyle Shore, July 12 (BC)

Black-bellied Plover - 1 at Noonan Shore, August 2 (DG)

Ruddy Turnstone - 6 at Argyle Shore, July 27 (BC)

Lesser Yellowlegs - 2 at Argyle Shore, July 14 (BC); 1 at Brudenell Aug 4 (GS)

Dunlin - 1 at Brudenell, August 4 (GS)

Dowitchers - 40 on July 16 and 68 on July 27 at Argyle Shore (BC)

Red-necked Phalarope - 6 on Fisherman's Bank on August 31 (JDM)

Iceland Gull - 1 seen on Fisherman's Bank, August 31 (JDM)

Common Tern - last young fledged off the Hillsborough Bridge Piers Aug. 28 (JDM)

Caspian Tern - 1 at Savage Harbour off north shore on August 16 (JDM)

Barred Owl - 1 in South Melville, July 1st (EC)

Whip-poor-will - 1 in Traveller's Rest, June 24 (JB)

Ruby-throated Hummingbird - 1 feeding 1 young in nest, August 26 (PS, JDM)

Barn Swallow - 30 at Sleepy Hollow, July 24 (EC)

Grey Jay - 1 at Redhead on July 7 (BP); 1 with 2 young seen in Dromore on July 9 (WM)

Northern Mockingbird - pair at Barrymoore Ct., Parkdale in early July (LK & BB)
 - pair built nest in snowball bush at Mount Stewart starting on July 12th; laid 3 eggs by July 20th; took food to nest July 30th; abandoned nest August 1st; constructed new nest by August 4 in a Cotoneaster; 1 egg laid August 7; 2nd egg laid August 8th; 3rd egg laid August 10; 1 young hatched August 22nd; 1 young fledged from the nest September 3rd. Congratulations to Bruce Pigot for this first nest record for P.E.I.

Black-and-white Warbler - migrants moving through in mid-August (GH, JDM)

Yellow-rumped Warbler - migrants moving through in mid-August (GH)

Bobolinks - sightings were down this summer with many traditional nesting areas having no Bobolinks. Adults singing May 19th at Argyle Shore (DW) and May 24th at Brackley (BH & JDM))

Blue Grosbeak - 1 at Tryon, June 1st, (BHo)

Indigo Bunting - 1 at Freeland feeder, May 12 & 13 (JN)

Pine Siskin - 1 at Argyle Shore, July 12 (BC)

Red-bellied Snake - Baldwin's Road, August 4 (GS); Spotted Salamander - 4 in small grass area next to Larch in Donagh Aug. 16 (JDM); Coyote tracks becoming numerous and sightings common in woodland in western Prince Edward Island (LH); minke whale being seen quite often on Fisherman's Bank last week of August (JM, DC); and fin whale seen occasionally on Fisherman's Bank last week of August (DC, JDM); 5 harbour seals at Georgetown Harbour between wharfs.
