International Wheat Pact Is Extended For One Year

LONDON (CP)—International Wheat Council, representing 49 wheat exporting and importing countries, have approved a one-year extension in the existing International Wheat Agreement which expires next July. It also decided to explore ways of developing a more comprehensive pact to replace the current arrangements in 1966.

The two-day council meeting, at which Canadian economist Dr. Claude Hudson presided, also discussed the stiff wheat price fight among Canada, the United States and Argentina and concluded that price cutting had run its course and the situation now would be stabilized.

Serious concern had been expressed in the council's hierarchy that the fight for markets involving an unprecedented drop of 20 cents a bushel over a five-day period last week might wreck the wheat agreement which was designed to stabilize world wheat trade.

STABILISATION LIKELY

The council, at which 36 member countries appeared, said in a statement Friday that the recent "adjustment" had brought wheat prices back to those prevailing in mid-1963 and that prices now would "stabilize at the new levels."

This seemed to suggest that world wheat prices now would tend towards the wheat agreement floor rather than towards the ceiling following a decline in world wheat demand which had reached peaks in the last two years. The existing three-year agreement, now to be extended to July 31, 1966, calls for a ceiling of \$2.02 1/2 (U.S.) for No. 1 Northern at the Lakehead and a floor of \$1.52 1/2.

Deputy Trade Minister J. H. Warren, Canada's chief delegate, said in an interview later that the one-year extension is "very satisfactory."

Many delegates had hoped for
