A Word in Season from a Practical Farmer.

This is perhaps the worst weed the farmer has to contend against. It has overrun some farms during the last few years rendering them almost useless for grain growing

It is just now coming in blossom in the early wheat, and as it is generally above the grain, its yellow flower can be seen quite a distance

There are some farms in this locality where this weed, has been allowed to multiply till it has taken complete possession

For those who have neglected this weed till it has taken possession there has been discovered a way to keep it in check if not destroy it altogether

Greater care should be exercised in buying our seeds in the spring. Much of the seed that was imported from Ontario and the United States this year was positively dirty and contained many weed seeds
