MONTREAL (CP) — Toronto Maple Leafs and Chicago Black Hawks will meet on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays to decide their best-of-seven Stanley Cup final, Clarence Campbell, president of the National Hockey League, confirmed Monday.

He said the official schedule for the playoff will see two games in Toronto before switching to Chicago. All games will start at 8 p.m. local time.

The full schedule is: At Toronto Tuesday, April 10, and Thursday, April 12; at Chicago Sunday, April 15, and Tuesday, April 17; at Toronto Thursday, April 19; at Chicago Sunday, April 22; and at Toronto, Tuesday, April 24.

The last three games are dependent on the length of the series.

Both clubs won their semifinal series in six games. Chicago sweeping past Montreal Canadiens and Toronto overcoming New York Rangers.

Soccer League Alleges Players Taking Drugs

MILAN (Reuters) — Italy's soccer league has alleged that three first-division clubs and eight of their players have been involved in drug-taking to improve performance.

A league statement Sunday night named the clubs and players and submitted the names to the league's commission of judges for possible disciplinary action.

The move followed the league's declaration of war on drug-taking two months ago which prompted medical examinations of players.

If a club is found guilty of "doping," the minimum fine is 1,000,000 lire (\$1,600). A player can be disqualified for a minimum of two playing days.

The league statement named eight players of Internazionale (Milan), Bologna and Mantova (Mantua) and said it sent medical reports with analyses from two laboratories to the commission of judges.

Imach Hints At Changes In Finals Against Hawks

TORONTO (CP) — Coach Punch Imach of Toronto Maple Leafs hinted Monday at possible lineup changes when the Leafs met Chicago Black Hawks Tuesday night in the Stanley Cup final, but left to the imagination what they might be.

"I may make some changes I'm not saying until game time what they'll be," Imach said after a Leaf workout.

The only Toronto player on the casualty list is leftwinger Bert Olmstead, who since March 11 with a cracked shoulder bone, Imach indicated the veteran, who early in his long career joined for the Hawks, is ready to play again but wouldn't say whether he'll get on the ice in the first game of the best-of-seven series. Game time is 8 p.m. EST.

"If I want Olmstead to play, he can play. But I have to talk to the doctor and I'm not going to use him until I'm sure he won't hurt the shoulder again."

HEAT MONTH AGO
Olmstead was hurt near the end of the March 11 game in Chicago, when he plunged into the boards after firing a shot at the Black Hawks' goal. He's been skating a couple of weeks.

This is the first time the Hawks, defending Stanley Cup champions, and the Leafs have met in the final since 1938 when Chicago won the then best-of-five series three games to one.

The Black Hawks, third-place finishers in the National Hockey League, reached the finals by upsetting the first-place Montreal Canadiens as they did last year, Toronto's second.

The semi-finals last year in an upset loss to Detroit Red Wings, sent New York Rangers to their summer jobs in this year's series semi-final.
