MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR RURAL DEVELOPMENT authority to complete the Shaw program in Agriculture, Fishing and Tourism. Triple the total production of P.E.I. in 5 years.

REDUCTION OF COST OF CLEARING LAND from \$12.00 to \$5.00 per hour.

REBATE 20% OF COST OF FERTILIZER for grains and pasture.

INCREASED FARM ESTABLISHMENT and enlargement loans from \$10,000 to \$20,000

FISHERMEN'S LOANS EXTENDED FROM 5 TO 8 YEARS to repay with our government financing 70% of the loan, "present and future".

VOCATIONAL SCHOOL TO BE BUILT IN EASTERN KINGS in a location acceptable to the Eastern Kings Board of Trade. New training school for fishermen in conjunction with it.

FAMILY HOUSING (500 homes for P.E.I.) and expansion of Senior Citizens housing to 500 units. At least 50 new low cost homes and as many Senior Citizens housing units as required for Souris and vicinity.

SCHOOL TAX IN SOURIS AND VICINITY WILL BE REDUCED BY \$80,000; and taxpayers of the Rollo Bay Consolidated Elementary School will save \$40,000. School capitalization grants increased from \$6,000 to \$10,000 per classroom.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO SOURIS and the new Eastern Kings fire department to provide service to rural areas. \$1,000 to each per unit per year.

NEW NATIONAL PARK IN YOUR DISTRICT and we endorse the alternate plan of the Eastern Kings Board of Trade.

PAVE ALL MAIN ROADS: Build All Weather Road from Charlottetown to Souris and Elmira.

MEDICAL CARE AVAILABLE TO ALL by July 1, 1967.

NEW STEEL DRAGGERS FOR SOURIS: Two new steel draggers are to be delivered to Souris this summer, two are being constructed for Souris, and six more are to be built to operate out of Souris. This will ensure year-round full employment for everyone.

NEW INDUSTRY FOR SOURIS. Crab and shell fishing are being researched, and this new industry will be based in Souris.

NEW PROCESSING PLANT. An Irish moss processing plant will be built in First Kings.

SALT MACKEREL PROCESSING. A large development is already taking place in a central part of the province. This new industry will be encouraged to expand to Eastern Kings.
