WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Island stands prorogued until Thursday, the Sixth day of August next:

I have thought fit, by and with the advice of Her Majesty's Executive Council, further to prorogue the said General Assembly, and the same is hereby prorogued until THURSDAY, the Tenth day of SEPTEMBER next, of which all persons concerned are required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

*Given under my hand and the Great Seal of this Island, at Charlottetown, in the said Island, this Fifth day of August, and in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty eight, and in the thirty-second year of Her Majesty's reign.*
