Bury Hatchet Honor Heroes For New Eire

DUBLIN, Sept. 8 (CP)—How old political antagonisms, caused by the civil war, are dying out in this part of the country is shown by the announcement that the de Valera government has decided to erect a permanent cenotaph to the memory of Arthur Griffith, Michael Collins and Kevin O'Higgins, three founders of the Irish Free State.

Griffith died, it is said, of a broken heart, shortly after the 1922 was begun between the Free Staters and the Republicans, in 1922; Collins, the gay and almost legendary hero of innumerable escapes from the British forces, fell in a hail of bullets during a guerrilla encounter between the rival Irish armies on a County Cork sideway. O'Higgins was assassinated one Sunday morning in 1927 as he was walking home from mass in a Dublin suburb.

Mr. Cosgrave's government caused the erection of a cenotaph to their memory beside the Dail buildings in Dublin but so bitter were the feelings of his opponents that they stayed away from annual commemorative ceremonies and these were officially discontinued when Mr. de Valera took office. In fact, the de Valera government surrounded the place with troops one week during unofficial commemorations, because of rumors that General John O'Duffy planned to lead his Blue Shirts on the central to effect a coup d'etat. O'Duffy backed down.

For Reconciliation

The Dublin Office of Works reports that the cenotaph, a temporary affair of lab and plaster, is in danger of collapse and the government announcement states it will be taken down and replaced as soon as possible by a permanent memorial. Designs are now being examined.

News of the de Valera government's move has naturally given satisfaction to Cosgrave supporters. Plans of Griffith and Collins have in Mr. de Valera's office in government buildings and on all main streets in the capital to effect a reconciliation.

It is reported that when de Valera's attention was once drawn to the danger of the cenotaph, he was told that it was not possible to reach the spot by the subway. He was told that the subway was not yet open and that the first torpedo struck amidst the

Sub Fires As Crew Abandon Sinking Ship

LISBON, Sept. 7 (AP)—Destruction of the 7,242-ton British ship Manna by a submarine was described tonight by a survivor brought to Lisbon who said the submarine opened fire as the crew of 88 sought to abandon the sinking ship.

Forty-six of the crew — three of them wounded — had been rescued. At least two were dead. Forty were missing.

Among the wounded was Thomas Jones, 50, of Carnarvon, North Wales, chief petty officer. He said the Manna had put up the best fight of which she was capable before she was sent to the bottom last night 100 miles off the Portuguese coast.

OFFICER TELLS STORY

Grimacing despite his leg wounds, he recalled: "We broke out a 12 pounder but we couldn't reach her (the submarine). She was too far away."

"The Manna's master, he said, gave orders to abandon ship after the first torpedo struck amidstships and it became evident that the submarine was not coming within range of the freighter's gun. "We launched four boats on the port side — the side away from the submarine — but the ship swung around as we were doing this. Jones said, "And we found ourselves staring straight at the submarine."
