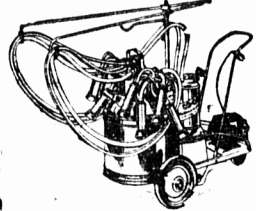

Then, making his way forward again, he cast off the painter and, settling himself down on the mid-ship thwart, got out a pair of oars and began to pull the boat clear of the land.

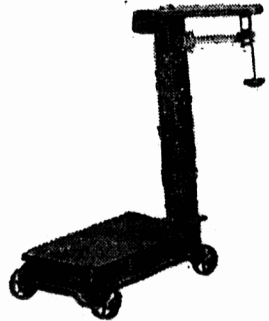
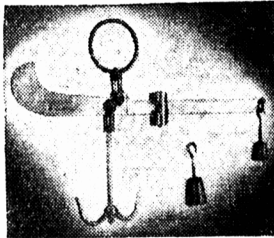
