Czechs Oust Representative Of Vatican

By NATE POLOWETZKY PRAGUE, March 18—(AP)—Czechoslovakia has ordered the Vatican's lone representative in this country to leave within three days, raising the possibility of a break in diplomatic relations with the Holy See.

The Vatican representative is Msgr. Otavio de Liva, secretary of the Papal Nunciature in Prague.

The Foreign Ministry accused him of abusing his official position by interfering in internal affairs of this Communist-ruled country.

The ouster of Msgr. De Liva climaxed a prolonged attack by the Communist press on the Vatican.

The Government recently expelled American Mormon missionaries and announced all Western missionaries would be ousted.

Roman Catholic sources said more than 60 priests have been arrested since the first of the year.

The Government has threatened state action against Archbishop Joseph Beran, the Catholic Primate, and his bishops.

The press has frequently accused Msgr. De Liva of "sowing disruption and unrest" and of carrying on "subversive activity."

The note ordering the ouster said the government did not recognize Msgr. De Liva as head of the Papal office and referred to him merely as "an employee of the Apostolic Internunciature."

HALIFAX March 18—Being introduced in Canadian service in the Maritimes, the first of twenty newly designed, streamlined Canadian National Railways sleeping cars was officially inspected here yesterday. It will be opened for public inspection today and on Monday prior to its entry into regular service on Tuesday.

The new, luxur, 24 low-priced roomette cars will be the first to be placed in service in Canada and will be first operated in the "Ocean Limited" between Halifax and Montreal. On that run they will also serve passengers travelling between Newfoundland and Sydney, Truro, Charlottetown and Sackville, Moncton and Saint John and intermediate points and Montreal.
