For 18 months, the talented actress has followed a hard and lonely course in untangling the financial mess left after her husband, comedian Ernie Kovacs, was killed in an auto crash.

Edie eschewed the help of Ernie's many famous friends, who proposed a television special or series to benefit the comedian's widow and orphaned children.

Instead, she undertook a non-stop schedule that included three movies, a series of television shows, night club and summer theatre tours and recorded albums.

Her industry succeeded in receding the estate from its burden of debts and unpaid taxes.

"NEARLY KILLED ME"  
"But I nearly killed me," she admitted. "After it was all over, I realized if I had to do just one thing more, I would have collapsed. I didn't have the energy."

Edie is back at her Goldwater Canyon home, getting it ready for the wedding. She and Marty will be married before their families only, with a big reception following at the Beverly Hilton.

"The first time I was in New York having dinner with Janet Leigh and her husband, Bob Brandt, the next day he called me for a date. I had to break it because of work, and it's a wonder he called me again."

"But he did, and our first was — Red Buttons' wedding! Later he took me to dinner at a very fancy restaurant, and I remember thinking how formal he was. I found out later he was thinking the same about me."

**Cattle Transfer Nears Completion**  
MARYSTOWN, Nfld. (CP) — A herd of 900 cattle completed a 3,500-mile train trip from the Flying L Ranch in Kirby, Sask., but still have 80 miles to go to their new home on southern Newfoundland's Burn Peninsula.

The cattle were unloaded from rail cars at Gooles and will begin the train drive in small herds to avoid tying up traffic.

Desired for the new Flying L Ranch just south of here, the animals are the largest shipment by rail in recent years. The herd is made up mostly of Hereford yearlings.

The cattle will join 100 others that have been thriving on the peninsula for nearly a year. The short grass growth on the barrens has proved sufficient for cattle feeding. Shortly before winter the animals will be moved north to Winterland, where bogland development has made cattle raising possible.

The cattle will form the basis of a breeding herd, part of a government-sponsored scheme to make the province more self-sufficient in beef. Sponsors of the project also see a beef market serving Europe from the Burn Peninsula.

### Chrysler Offer Goes To Owners Of Rootes' Stock

LONDON (Reuters) — Formal offers by the American Chrysler Car Corporation for a £12,300,000 (\$36,900,000) stake in Britain's Rootes car group were mailed to the Rootes' shareholders here.

Enclosed with the offers was a letter from the British company's chairman, Lord Rootes, backing the deal because of the "added strength" it would bring to the British group.

The letter and the offer documents, Rootes' profits for the year just ended were expected to show a jump from £415,000 to £2,000,000.

Chrysler now is bidding for a 30-per-cent stake in the controlling ordinary shares and 50 per cent in non-voting A shares.

These are 34 shillings and sixpence (£8.67) for the ordinary and 21 shillings (£5.13) for the A shares. Current market prices are 20 shillings and fourpence halfpenny and 14 shillings and sevenpence halfpenny.

After clashes in the House of Commons over the deal, Chrysler gave an undertaking to take no steps toward acquiring a controlling interest in Rootes against the wishes of the government.

For the next few weeks Ottawa Man Leaves Hospital After Transplant Of Kidney

MONTREAL (CP) — Vernon Trewin, one of a handful of people in the world to undergo a rare kidney transplant operation successfully, has left Montreal's Royal Victoria Hospital for his Ottawa home.

The 35-year-old civil servant was discharged during the weekend but decided to stay on at the hospital until Monday for a checkup. He had been in hospital since last October. The operation was performed Nov. 7.

Doctors who performed the difficult operation said Mr. Trewin now has three kidneys — the transplanted organ and his two poorly functioning ones.

He said the factor in the operation is the factor in the body which rejects a transplant from another body in the same way that invasive infection is fought off. This immunity factor was suppressed in Mr. Trewin's case by means of drugs.

During the tricky period after the operation he was protected by antibiotic medications to offset reduction of natural defences against germs. He will continue to take the drugs for the rest of his life.
