SDU Graduating Class Takes Over Spotlight

In a ceremony starting at 3 o'clock this afternoon 67 senior students of St. Dunstan's University will pass one of the major milestones of their early careers when they are presented with their diplomas and certificates indicating the winning of their degrees following four years of studies.

The graduating class is comprised of 39 Bachelors of Arts, 16 Bachelors of Science, six Bachelors of Education and four Bachelors of Commerce.

The annual commencement exercises will be presided over by Most Rev. Malcolm A. MacEachern, Bishop of Charlottetown, in his capacity as Chancellor of the University. His Excellency will also confer the degrees, honorary degrees and diplomas on the successful graduates.

Those receiving degrees have completed the prescribed courses of studies in the fields of education, arts, science and commerce. The seven completing studies in the engineering field will be presented with diplomas.

In addition to the regular graduating class, three prominent men are scheduled to receive honorary Doctor of Laws degrees. They are: Professor Joseph Henri Blanchard, Charlottetown; Mr. Justice Mark R. MacGuigan, Charlottetown; and Dr. Colin B. MacKay, president of the University of New Brunswick.

Another highlight of the exercises to which the faculty, students, honored guests and the public are looking forward is the address to the graduates by Dr. MacKay.

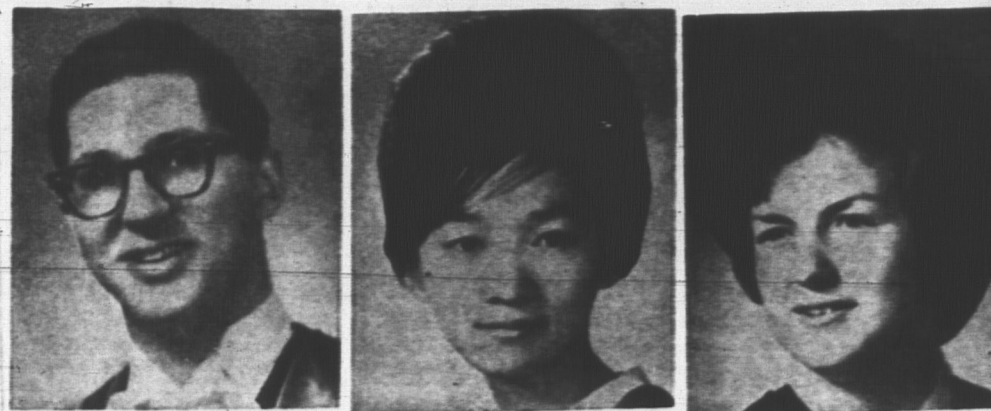

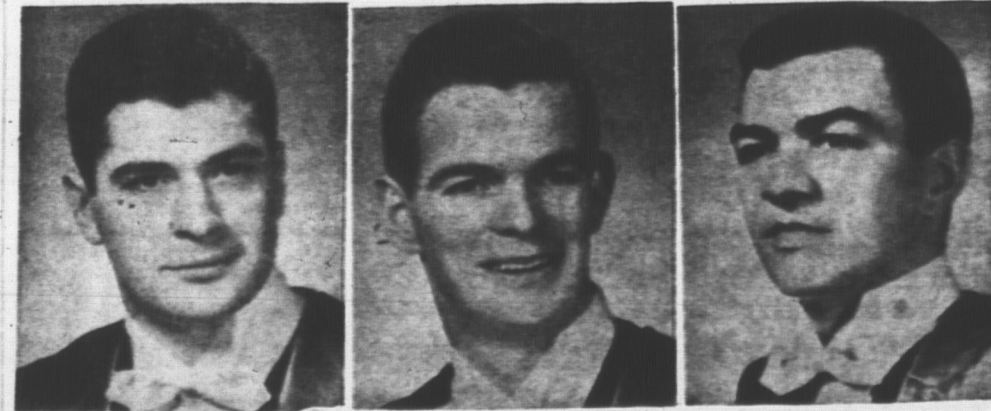

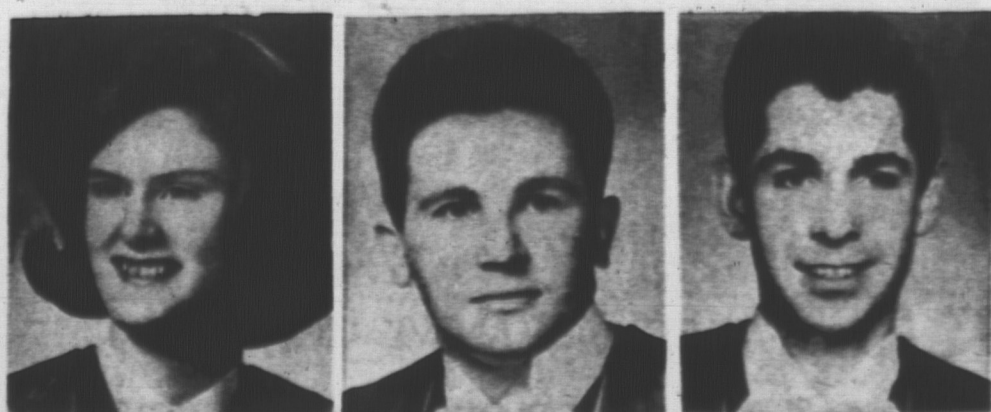
