## Foreign Service Prep Seminar

A prep course on the Foreign Service exam is proving the old adage: "Forewarned is forearmed". Individuals who take the seminar taught by former Foreign Service officer Barry Yeates are three times as likely to be offered jobs in Canada's Foreign Service as those in the general test-taking group. Now expanded to a two-day format, the seminar prepares individuals for the Foreign Service exam and subsequent interviews. This highly successful program will be offered at thirteen universities from Halifax to Victoria between September 21 and October 19 (see attached schedule).

This year's exam for entry-level diplomatic positions in the

aid, trade, immigration, and political streams of Canada's Foreign Service is on Saturday, October 21, at universities coast to coast. Degree-holders and students in their graduating year in any discipline are eligible to enter

this competition for approximately 120 jobs.
