research and development takes 8 to 10 years. Two years ago there was a 60% increase in jobs available for graduates. A year later it rose again, therefore job opportunities are now possible because the number of jobs exceeds the current supply of graduates. Dr. Meincke summed up with his two main points of emphasis: the time lag between what is available when the student commences his studies and when he finishes them must be overcome, and whatever motivates students must be changed to meet national

requirements.

Mr. Brown foresaw that it would be the students who will eventually affect

the task force presentation to the government.

Since the smallness and lack of industry on PEI limits the produce it can export on the world market, the only solution is for the Island to become the academic centre of the Maritimes. If that is the case, more funding and expertise will be needed to prepare for the uncertainty of the 80's.

Mr. Brown deplored the fact that many schools here and elsewhere do not recommend UPEI to their students because of its supposed low quality.

Also presenting briefs were representatives for the natives, the disabled and handicapped, the women, and the contractors on PEI.

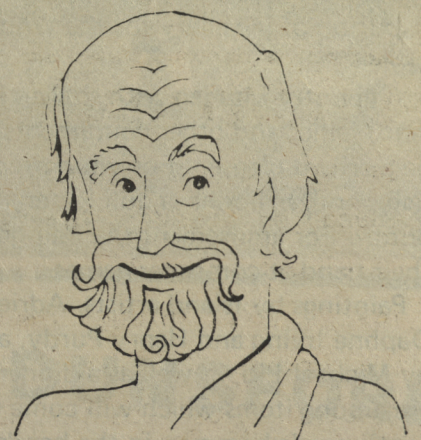
