

**TWO SPINSTERS  
FOIL BANDITS**

BRISTOL, England (Reuters) — Two elderly spinster sisters, Amy and Ada Blackmore, routed two bandits from their tiny post office, repeating a performance which won them the Queen's commendation for bravery ten years ago.

One bandit leaped onto the counter when 66-year-old Amy had her back turned. Amy unhesitatingly swung around and knocked the man off the counter with a right hook.

As the man picked himself off the floor, Ada, 61, rushed in and the pair started screaming so loud that the men fled.

Police are still searching for the men.

Ten years ago, the sisters helped capture two men who later were jailed.

**ECM Queries  
Are Answered  
In U.K. House**

LONDON (AP) — Relations between Britain and the Commonwealth will not be affected by American pressure once Britain entered the European Common Market, Deputy Foreign Minister Edward Heath has assured Parliament. In fact, he denied any such pressure existed.

Robert Turton, a Labor MP, had asked in the House of Commons:

"Will you give an assurance that the government will not allow the relationship between Britain and the Commonwealth to be altered at the dictate of the U.S. government?"

He was apparently referring to a recent statement by George Ball, U.S. undersecretary of state, that Commonwealth tariff preference should not be retained after Britain entered the Common Market.

**DENIED BY HEATH**

Heath, chief negotiator for Britain's entry into the Common Market, denied the U.S. government had made it clear British entry into the market would involve, after the transitional period, the disappearance of the Commonwealth system of preference.

"This is not the view expressed to us," he said.

Labor MP Marcus Lipton asked if Heath was aware any attempt to "bulldoze, hoodwink or prejudice Canada, Australia, or any other Commonwealth country would be regarded as a gross betrayal."

Heath said there was no question of the Commonwealth being treated in that way.
