First Aid For Ailing Houses

CUTTING DOWN FADING
QUESTION: Is the amber used inside retail store windows for the purpose of eliminating the effect of direct and reflected sunlight on displayed materials? We have a north and east exposure living and dining room. Carpeting and upholstered furniture have faded considerably. An interior decorator told us that the fading is due to sunlight reflected from the stone house to the north of us and from reflected sunlight from snow during winter months. Would amber colored material be available in window shades?

ANSWER: Yes, the amber colored material is for the purpose you mention. It is a very thin plastic material, made into a window shade or "screen", consult any window shade maker. If you could use fiberglass curtains over your windows; this is now available at many draperies and textile stores in a wide assortment of weights, weights, patterns and finishes. Fiberglass materials are resistant to sun, heat, fading etc.

DISCOLORED VINYL
QUESTION: I placed rubber caps on legs of chrome kitchen chairs. These have discolored my vinyl floor covering, leaving deep orange stains that spread. What, if anything, will remove these stains?

ANSWER: Only suggestions I can offer are the following: Try removing the discoloration with a liquid polishing wax, made by a nationally known directions carefully. If not successful, try using the wax with a fine steel wool, rubbing carefully. Or use a floor-cleaning preparation with the steel wool, followed by immediate rinsing with clear water and drying, then waxing.

PAINT PEEL OFF STONE
QUESTION: Our fireplace is made of large natural stones. The mortar, raised and rounded rather than smoothed in, was originally dark. I painted it light, but have never been satisfied with it. Do not wish to cover stone with wood paneling.

ANSWER: The disadvantage of painting stone or brick fireplace, is that, once painted, the porous nature of these materials makes future paint removal difficult if not impossible. In other words, the fireplace will have to remain painted. The paint won't peel off due to heat from the fireplace, provided the coating is applied to an absolutely clean surface and according to label instructions. Use either a resin emulsion paint, or a cement base paint. Don't know what color your

room walls are presently painted, but remember that painting in pale colors makes walls appear to recede and the room seems larger therefore. Painting the fireplace the same color as the walls will make it less conspicuous.

ROOFING FOR SUN DECK
QUESTION: We are purchasing a house that has an attached garage with a flat roof. We want to use the roof as a sun deck, covering it with canvas for this purpose. Where can we obtain the roofing canvas?
ANSWER: Roofing canvas is available from roofing supplies dealers, together with instructions for its application. Be sure the material is labelled as roofing canvas, since other types are not suitable for this purpose.

U.S. Pulls Out Of Air Treaty

WASHINGTON (AP) — The United States is pulling out of a treaty that regulates the liability of international airlines, despite a move to raise the limit to \$50,000 a passenger.
U.S. officials have been demanding an interim agreement setting \$75,000 as the maximum, that may be collected from an airline for a passenger's death or injury, with a long-range permanent limit of \$100,000.
The International Air Transport Association announced in Montreal that its member airlines have agreed by mail vote to raise the limit of their liability.

FIND ANCIENT BAUBLE
MOSCOW (Reuters)—A necklace of polished animal bones made 30,000 to 40,000 years ago has been found 10 feet below the surface in excavations in the ancient city of Uzbekistan in Samarkand.

The limit fixed by the 1929 Warsaw convention, when air transport was a fledgling industry, was \$5,000. This was doubled to \$16,600 by the 1955 Hague protocol, to which neither the United States nor Britain subscribed.

The State Department announced Oct. 26, following a long series of conferences with the airlines, that it intended to serve notice Nov. 15 that it was withdrawing from the Warsaw pact. Actual withdrawal becomes effective six months after serving this "notice of denunciation."
U.S. officials said at the time that the United States might change its mind if a satisfactory interim agreement could be worked out before Nov. 15, providing for a \$75,000 liability limit.

Dief Says Feels Better About Vote

WINNIPEG (CP) — Conservative Leader Diefenbaker said he feels better about the Nov. 8 federal election situation now than when he started campaigning Sept. 8.

At an airport press conference he said that "after all that strenuous campaigning I've increased in weight and I know in political stature."

Mr. Diefenbaker stopped off in Winnipeg on his way to Edmonton from Montreal for a night rally.

He insisted again as he has before: "We're going to have a majority government and we are going to form it."

He said he was "most happy at the prospects" in Quebec province. People are starting to realize, he said, that proposals

He said the government campaign has run into difficulties. The Liberals had had a record of alteration and retreat.
Mr. Diefenbaker described as false a claim by Prime Minister Pearson that the Old Age Pension increase proposed by the Conservatives would result in higher taxes.
He said there would be no tax increase under his proposal to increase pensions to \$100 from \$75 with money collected under the new Canada Pension Plan.

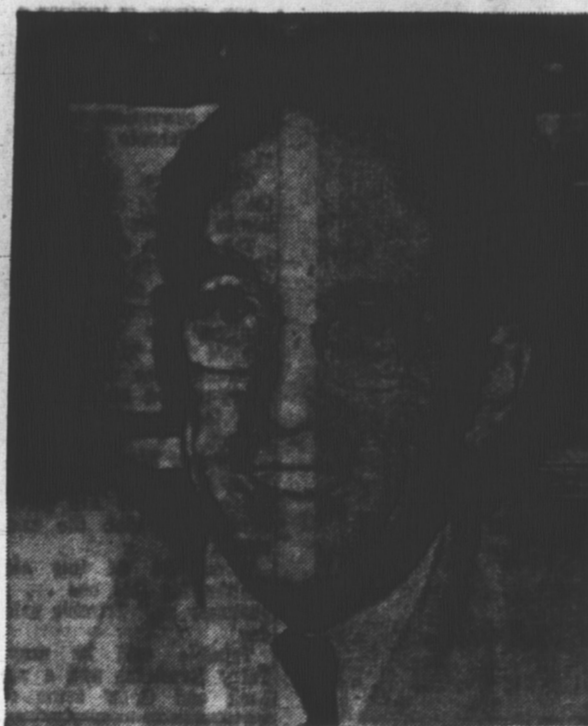
