Toronto Stocks

TORONTO, (CP) - The stock market's "penny boom" tottered on its last legs Thursday as trading volume dropped to its lowest point since Jan. 12. Golds and western oils each lost more than half an index point. Uranium and New Brunswick base metals traded lower. Volume was 3,962,000.

A wide list of low-priced mining issues traded but few achieved the heavy trading interest of early boom seasons. New Brunswick base metals were mixed as New Larder U slipped and a few other issues gained.

A few western oils traded actively as the list declined. Leading losers were Britisha, Canadian Atlantic, Central Leduc, Commoil and Commonwealth.

Senior golds slipped as McIntyre dropped \$1.50 and others weakened. Juniors also slipped and holding companies showed a wide list of losses.

NEW YORK, (AP) - The stock market maintained a steady front Thursday in the face of continued uncertainties arising from the illness of Premier Stalin. The market managed to stage a mild recovery movement that took it from the downside, where it hung most of the day, to the upside at the close.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks added 20 cents at \$113.60 with the industrial component up 23 cents, the railroads up 40 cents, and the utilities unchanged.

Volume came to 1,540,000 shares. Higher were American Telephone, Santa Fe, Baltimore and Ohio, Standard Oil NJ, Homestake Mining, Jefferson Lake Sulphur, American Woolen, Pacific Western Oil, Chrysler, Boeing and Radio Corp.
