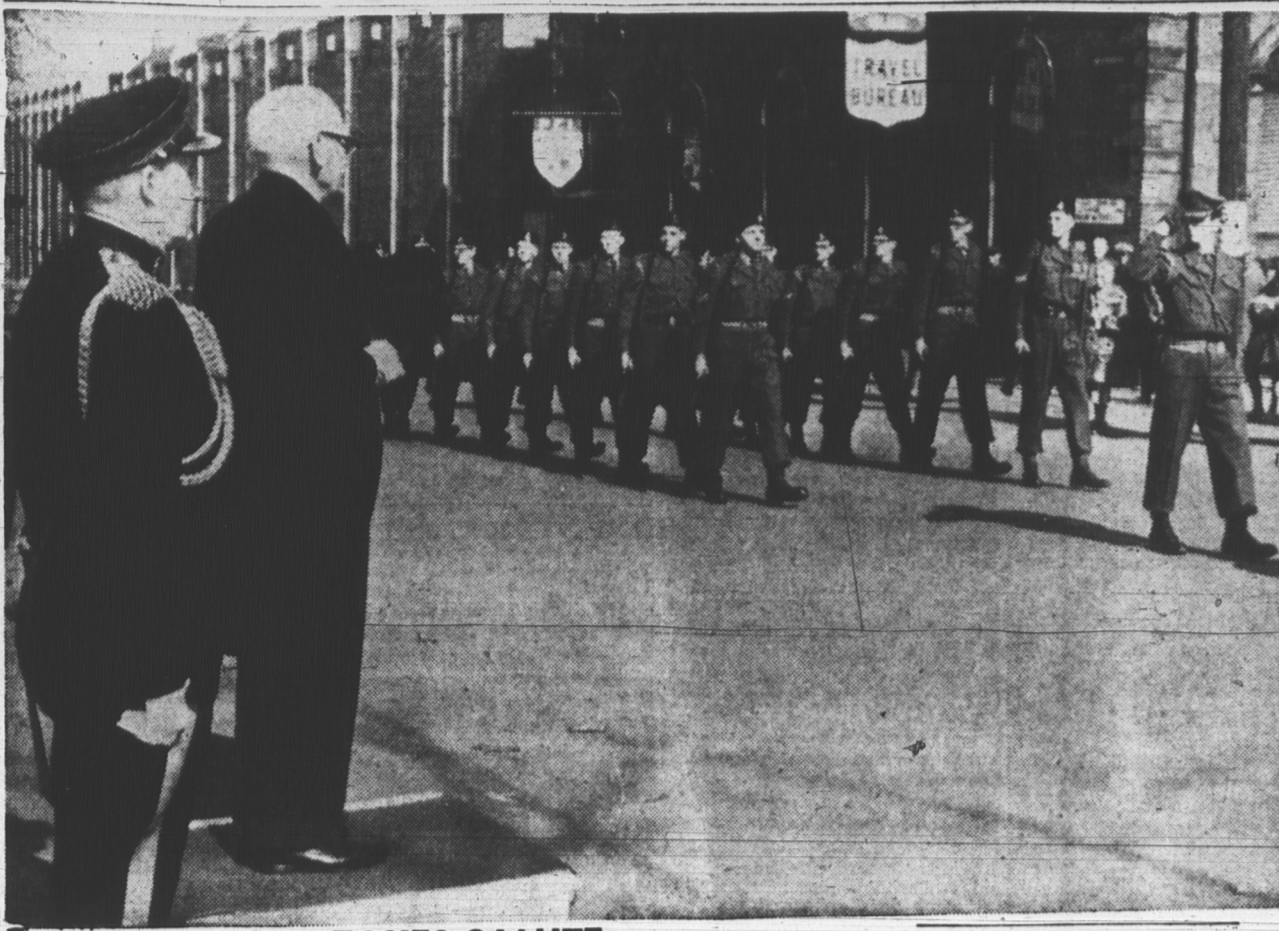

## Liquid Hydrogen As Fuel Gives Trouble In Space

CAPE KENNEDY, Fla. (AP)—Taming liquid hydrogen fuel in space continued to elude space agency scientists as they began piecing together the reasons a Centaur rocket failed to ignite twice in space Thursday night.

The space agency must master this technological trick before it can commit astronauts to rocket to the moon. Liquid hydrogen provides 40 per cent more power than other liquid fuels and also has more lifting capacity than the most powerful solid fuels now in use.

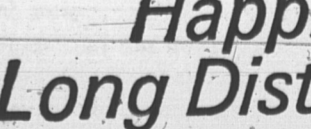

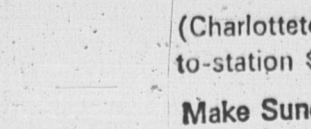
