Many graduate schools are now asking prospective candidates to write an admission test as part of their entrance requirements. For the benefit of those who plan to pursue graduate work, the following is a list of these examinations and dates on which they will be written. (The asterisk denotes that a centre is established at U.P.E.I. and the test will be written here on that date.)

Where no asterisks appear, the test is being administered at another University, usually Dal. It is possible, however, that with early application (6 weeks prior to test date), we may be granted permission to establish a centre at U.P.E.I. even though we are not officially listed as one for that particular date.
