Sports Events And Election Hold Spotlight At College

 The Blue and White of St. Dunstan's Xavier rebelled against the odds makers and rallied to down Acadia and gain the N.S. Basketball laurels, then stumbled to a 48-36 decision over SDU in the first game of the "best of 3" series for the Maritime Crown.

St. F.X. was had, but St. Dunstan's was not, as the final game for the highest hoop honors failed to hit the half-century mark, over forty minutes of frenzied playing. Only the flashy ball controlling of Bob Neopollano and Bob Charnard saved St. F.X. from looking as bad as the Red and White. It was obvious that both teams were off their form and the tension connected with so important an encounter, may have stunted a basketball game that was lacking in the p.o.s.e and finish expected of these two evenly-matched finalists.

By the time this column goes to rest the second and perhaps the final game of the series will be over. The time for the second encounter was Fri. 7 o'clock (last night). people. Also higher education is a prerequisite to the attaining of greater skills which are becoming more and more demanded for the job market. Today ability or inability to compete in a competitive market may mean industrial failure or success.

We feel that there are three questions to be resolved: "First: Do we desire these better and greater opportunities for our young people?" "Second: Are we, under the present facilities and program, able to provide them?" "Third: If our system of education is not able to provide necessary facilities, are we able and willing to provide them?" We believe that we desire the best for our young people that it is possible to procure, which answers the first question.

It would seem that there are not nearly enough scientists, engineers, technicians, and students to fill the need, even for present demands, even though our universities are filled to capacity with students.

We believe that this country is financially able to provide academic and technical training as it was able to provide military training in an earlier emergency. Can we not provide similar training for peaceful purposes?

Willingness to provide the necessary finances for necessary training must be demonstrated by governments, municipal, provincial, and federal if the best is to be achieved in this field of training.

We believe that we should all have the facilities now available to the youth of our country.

It is not a question of whether we can afford to do more than we are doing. It seems to us that we must not afford to do less than we ought to do.

Facilities Must Be Provided To Educate Young People
