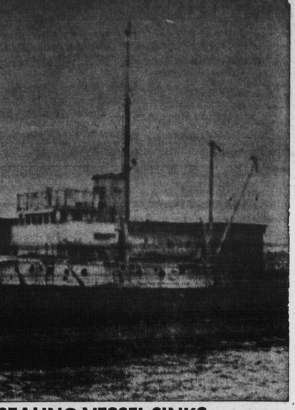

After the market close came news that Pittsburgh steel was raising prices for certain steel products.

Oil, drugs, tobacco, some metals, electrical equipment and selected issues in the other group helped boost the list.
