

## Free Trade Issue Warmed, Chilled At Montreal Talks

MONTREAL, C.P.—The old question of freer trade was alternately warmed by governmental enthusiasm and chilled by commercial caution at the opening session of the 96th annual meeting of the Canadian Manufacturers' Association here.

The enthusiasm came from Trade Minister Winters, who told the 1,500 delegates he was happy to say the pace of the protracted trade negotiations at Geneva has quickened after a long delay caused by internal disputes.

The caution was provided in a CMA report which suggested the crucial points of the talks—called the Kennedy round after the influence of the late president Kennedy in getting them started—still is to come.

The report prepared by General Manager J. C. Whitelaw, also warned that if the talks fail, the United States will bring considerable pressure on Canada to sign a new bilateral trade agreement.

Mr. Winters agreed in his address that in talks as large as the Geneva negotiations the results can never be counted on until the package has been put together and paid for in a mutually acceptable basis.

**GIVE AND TAKE**  
But he added he has a feeling of movement in a positive direction and a willingness by all countries to see what can be accomplished through give and take.

"I believe there is also the necessary awareness that the negotiations must be pushed ahead at all speed and with a sense of urgency, if advantage

is to be taken of the U.S. tariff-cutting authority before its expiry in mid-1967.

Mr. Winters said a successful outcome to the talks would mean much for Canada, not only in opening up additional export chances, but also in providing opportunities for achieving the economies of large-scale production.

The CMA report said the crucial period for the talks will come during the next few months and added the key points of negotiations will be in industrial products covering steel, chemicals, aluminium, pulp and paper and textiles.

**POINTS TO DANGERS**  
Expressing concern about possible U.S. pressure if the talks fail, the report said any tariff concessions made by Canada to the U.S. would have to be extended to other countries under Canada's most-favored-nation trading policy, without getting matching concessions from these countries.

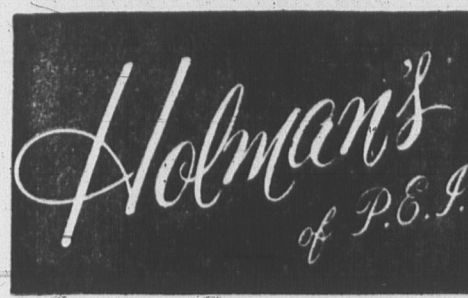
It also said the CMA expects attempts will be made in the Geneva talks to weaken Canada's anti-dumping regulations and asked the government to tread warily if either eventuality develops.

In his address Mr. Winters asked manufacturers not to let up in their drive for export sales.

The challenge facing exporters was to increase production to the limit of capacity with a minimum of inflation.

In other association business, Mr. Whitelaw called on labor leaders to do something about what he called numerous examples of unions defying the law.

Until the attitude changed substantially, Canada would continue to face a crisis.

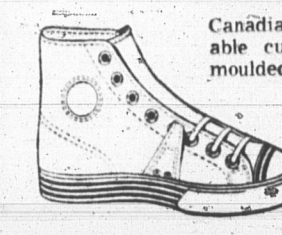

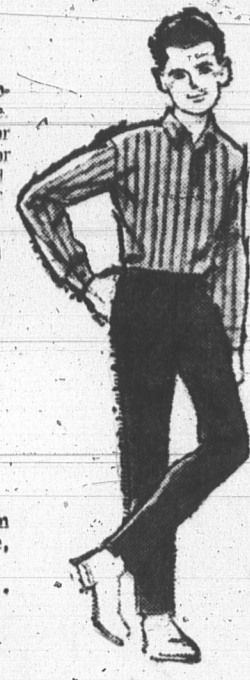

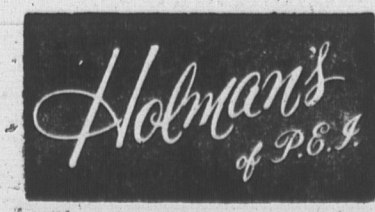

## Kennedy Addresses South African Student Union

CAPE TOWN (Reuters)—U.S. Senator Robert Kennedy has described apartheid (race separation) as an evil and called on youthful South Africans to strip away the "illusion of difference based on color."

In the major speech of his controversial visit to the South African republic—where separation of the races is official policy—he made a vigorous plea for equality and justice for the Negro majority.

"We must recognize the full human equality of all our people before God, before the law, and in the councils of government," the 40-year-old New York democrat said.

He called on his audience of young students at the University of Cape Town to forego timidity and comfort. Moral courage, he said, is the one essential, vital quality for those who seek to change a world which yields most painfully to change.

Kennedy was addressing the National Union of South African Students, which invited him to make the visit.

Premier Hendrik Verwoerd's government has officially ignored the senator's visit, calling it strictly private.

His intended host, students union leader Ian Robertson, has been restricted by the government under the Suppression of Communism Act.

Kennedy's main approach was to point up the efforts being made in the United States to give civil rights to the Negro.

In one of his few mentions of apartheid, he listed it among several current world evils. Others included racial discrimination in New York, starvation in Indian streets and jailing of intellectuals in the Soviet Union.

"These are differing evils; but they are the common works of man," he said. "They reflect the imperfection of human justice, the inadequacy of human compassion, the defectiveness of our sensibility toward the sufferings of our fellows. They mark the limit of our ability to use knowledge for the well-being of others."

**CELEBRATES FIRST MASS**  
TORONTO (C.P.)—Rev. William T. Clarke, 33—believed to be the first Canadian-born Negro to be ordained as a Roman Catholic priest—celebrated his first mass Sunday. Father Clarke was ordained in the Jesuit order Saturday by Bishop Benjamin I. Webster at Regis College.

Of Mr. Johnson, who strongly opposed the Fulton-Favreau constitutional amending formula, Mr. Fulton said he had come to have a "warm personal friendship and regard for him."

He was certain the Quebec government will be in capable hands under Mr. Johnson and paid tribute to Mr. Johnson's campaigning and organizational ability.
