ARMENIAN SLAUGHTER.

Report of a Writer Who Visited a Scene of Recent Massacres.

The following letter has been received in Boston from a trustworthy American who has been the companion of an English Consul in a trip through a part of the Sasson region, where the survivors of the recent massacre are. He says: "I write this sitting by the altar in a deserted church, where its two martyred pastors, Dr. Kechian and Dr. Hohannes, were performing their last office, for their simple-minded, infatigable people last year at this time. As the houses are in ruins, and we have naught save a poor tent to accommodate us amid abnormal rains and winds for this time of season, we besake ourselves here for mere stability and comfort, now and then.
