## WAR NEWS.

### GREEK SUCCESS AT PHARSALOS.

Greek Princes and Troops Congratulated.

Decisive Battle Expected To-day

ENGLISH INTERVENTION PRESSED.

The Opinion of a Correspondent.

ATHENS, May 6.—There is great rejoicing here over the news that the Turks were repulsed at Pharsalos.

Crown Prince Constantine and Prince Nicholas fought courageously in the front ranks. The government has sent them congratulations, and has also congratulated the troops upon their bravery and steadiness.

The public are overjoyed and are already forgetting the early blunders of the campaign. A decisive battle will, it is expected, be fought at Pharsalos today (Thursday).

NEW YORK, May 6.—The London correspondent of the Sun cables: England, as Mr. Curzon announced in the House of Commons yesterday, is again pressing the question of intervention,—this time with success. The impression grows in all quarters that the submission of Greece to Turkey and the Powers will soon be forthcoming.

It is not unlikely that the end of the hostilities will take the form of a brief armistice. This gained, nobody believes that fighting will ever be resumed.

### NEWS FROM THE CAPITAL

#### PARLIAMENT OF CANADA.

Senator Ferguson Seeks and Gains Some Information.

No Arrangements Made for Co-operation in Respect to Hillsborough Bridge.

OTTAWA, May 6.—Yesterday was private members' day.

The afternoon was occupied with first readings and motions for papers.

On one motion a discussion arose on the dismissals of postmasters and other country officials.

The evening session was devoted to the discussion, upon the second reading of Mr. Casey's bill to compel railways to carry bicycles free, as personal baggage.

In the Senate, Hon. Mr. Ferguson moved for correspondence on financial matters between the Federal Government and the Ministry of Prince Edward Island. Also for papers relating to the employment of the steamer Petrel as a ferryboat between Prince Edward Island and the mainland.

He said that the Petrel was entirely unfitted for the work and only made two or three trips across the straits.

Senator Scott informed Senator Ferguson that no arrangements had yet been made to co-operate with the provincial Government in the construction of the Hillsborough River Bridge, but that \$7,500 had been placed in the estimates to cover the cost of a survey.
