

Whalers Frozen In. THIRTEEN WHALERS AND SIX HUNDRED MEN IMPRISONED IN THE ARCTIC OCEAN.

The whaling bark J. A. Howland, which arrived at San Francisco a few days ago, brings news that 13 whalers are shut in the ice about 20 miles from Herald Island, almost the identical place where the Jeanette was first caught. On board the vessels were between 500 and 600 men. With their catch the vessels represent \$525,000. There is little hope of escape. The catch was very poor until the latter part of August, when the whalers, becoming desperate, took great risks in running up little coves in the ice after whales. They caught several, but suddenly the ice came and before they could escape 13 were firmly hemmed in. On Sept. 26th a relief party was sent out from Fox Island with wood and clothes in two whaling steamers, but a storm set in the relief could not reach the imprisoned whalers. At last accounts the vessels were drifting westward toward the Siberian Coast, following the course of the unfortunate bark Napoleon three years ago, from which only one man escaped after two years of almost incredible hardships in the Arctic. Oil whalers have but small hopes of the rescue of any of the imprisoned men. Escape over the ice is almost impossible, even with a large stock of provisions, whereas these vessels are simply supplies for the cruise which ends Nov. 1, on their arrival at San Francisco. The American Government will probably send a relief vessel at once, but the chances of the season is against success. Still, the whaler Amethyst was rescued by the revenue cutter Richard Rush as late as November. The officers of the whaling companies are besieged by the wives and other relatives of the missing whalers. The bark Reindeer is said to have been crushed with 40 men on board. The vessels caught are the barks Andrew Hicks, Lancer, Mars, Osceola, Ohio, Seacord, Reindeer and William Baylies of New Bedford, and the barks Hestia Hunter, John West, Seabreeze and Pasano, of San Francisco.

Dust In Flour Mills.

The Lancet reports that in order to test the effect of constant inhalation of dust in flour mills on the animal organism, M. L. Poincarre kept guinea pigs for two years in the most dusty part of a flour mill—that is to say, the department, where the corn is cleaned from all extraneous matter by a special machine before being ground. Of twenty animals, ten remained alive at the end of two years. Those that died were mostly young ones. None of these showed traces of tuberculosis, but catarrhal pneumonia with profuse dysquamation of epithelium; also in some cases localized in testicular pneumonia and extravasation of blood. Dust, consisting of grains of starch, etc., was found, more particularly on the nasal mucous membrane, but only to a small extent in the bronchi.

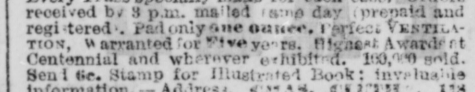
