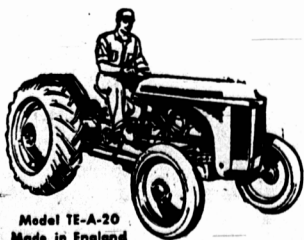

A Country Garden

faces there will be later blooming flowers to take their place in the front of them. Oriental Poppies and Irises can be used in this way, also Foxglove and Peonies—these are taller plants. I usually plant Perennial Phlox nearer the front of the border because it blooms in August and September. Hollyhocks are good toward the back of the border with the Michaelmas Daisies nearer the front as they are one of the latest flowers to bloom. Some of the borders in this garden are twelve to fifteen feet wide but when the garden was new they were only six feet in width. The space set apart for the garden determines the width that will give the best effect. The house should be taken into consideration too.

In the placing of tall flowers do not plant them in a row at the back of the border but bring some of them forward and the effect will be much better. Annuals planted as an edging to a perennial border means that the garden looks gay with bright color for a much longer period than short blooming perennials can provide through the season. Fragrant Alyssum is one of the best and Petunias or Ageratum are attractive for this purpose. Marigolds and the small Zinnias are also suitable. I hope some of these suggestions will be helpful to the reader who asked for this information.

Violets are blooming in the rock garden and their fragrance and their deep blue almost purple color make them one of the finest flowers that I have in the spring.
