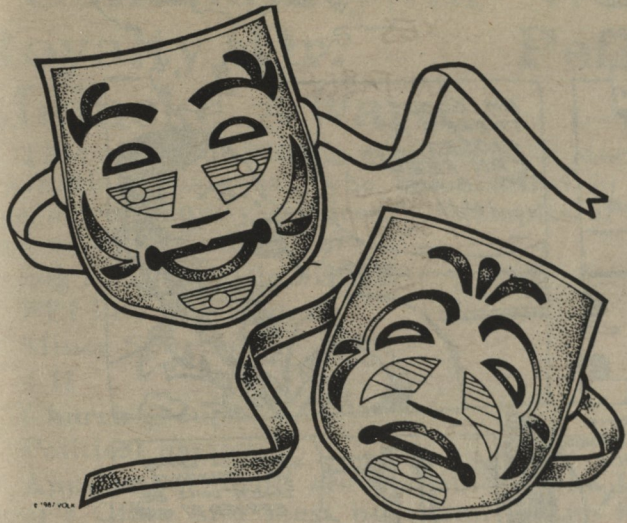


OEDERLAND ONE WEEK AWAY



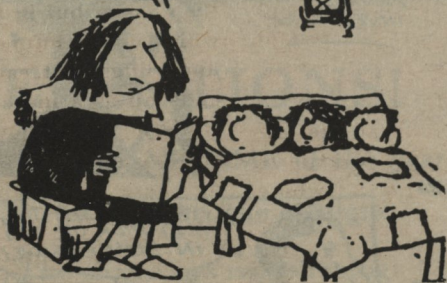
