Forecasts Cuts In Prices Of Farm Produce

GUELPH, Ont., July 24 (CP)—Some reduction in farm produce prices—although not necessarily meat prices—was forecast today by H. H. Hannam president of the Federation of Agriculture.

Dr. Hannam was addressing the annual joint meeting of the American Farm Economic Association and the Canadian Agricultural Economics Society.

He said the carry over of feed grains and the likelihood of a large crop this year would result in cuts in produce prices. However, meat prices would only be slightly affected since their present high level resulted from export to the United States at U. S. prices.

Dr. Hannam said the price situation at present is satisfactory to the agriculturist. He was afraid, however, that Canadian agricultural economy, based upon its exports, would suffer in the long run from present anti-inflationary controls.
