

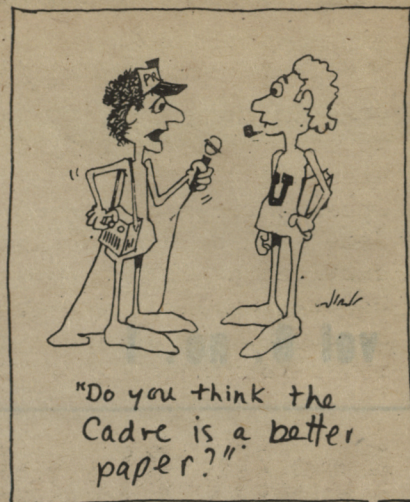
EDITORIAL
