**Highway Safety Promotion Called Weak And Confused**

NORTH BAY (CP) - Efforts to promote highway safety have been weak and confused and much more should be done to reduce death and injury tolls, the Ontario Chamber of Commerce was told here.

The chamber, holding its 54th annual meeting, was urged to take the lead in the field of accident prevention and highway safety through a detailed study of the problem.

The 300 delegates referred to the question back to the chamber's traffic committee for a year's study after they had been assured that the chamber executive would press the government on it as soon as possible.

-Rigorous enforcement of existing laws;  
-Greater co-ordination between magistrates and sentencing officers to eliminate a definite tendency in some quarters to minimize penalties;  
-Compulsory driver training in secondary schools;  
-More control over drivers.

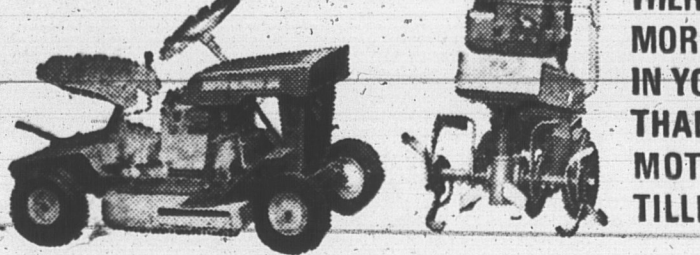
