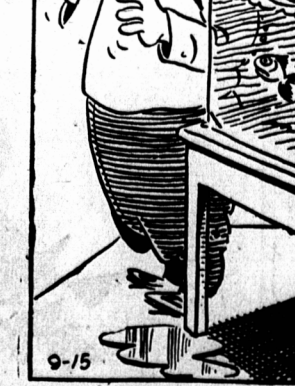

Who is Eligible?
 Any man or woman who has been discharged after service in the Canadian naval, military or air forces during World War II.
 Any man or woman who has been discharged after service in the naval, military or air forces of His Majesty during World War II, who was living in Canada at the commencement of such service.
 The widow or widower of a veteran as above, if the veteran was not insured under the act.
 Certain classes of Merchant Seamen. Members of the Corps of (Civilian) Canadian Fire Fighters and Auxiliary Services Supervisors, with service overseas.
