### Pruning Apple Trees.

While there is a difference of opinion as to the best time to prune apple trees I think good reasons can be given for pruning now. Pruning in March I think is advisable. Surplus branches can be taken off and removed to the brush pile during the fine days from now until the sap starts with a little inconvenience as at any time of the year.

Do not think pruning is an operation that should be performed only once in a few years. It is a continuous operation, lasting from the time the tree is planted until its usefulness is gone. A great mistake is often made by doing severe pruning after the tree has been neglected. There is a limit to pruning and successful results can only be obtained by doing a certain amount each year. With young trees pruned to correct bad habits of growth. Young trees should be watched and the formation of undesirable and crowding limbs prevented. Suckers and shoots should be cut away. Have, if possible a well balanced tree with a good central leading branch. When removing a branch do not leave a part of it to decay and cut so as to leave as small a surface to heal over as possible.

If a limb has been carefully taken off with a saw it is not necessary to smooth the wound with a knife. It is quite necessary, however, to cover the wound with some material. For that purpose, everything considered, probably thick white lead paint will fill the bill as well as anything. I use grafting wax made as follows: 5 parts of resin, 2 parts of bees wax and enough linseed oil to overcome brittleness. After melting the above materials together add one half part of linseed oil. Then pour a little of this mixture into water and when cool enough to work do so. After it has been thoroughly worked by hand allow a small piece to become thoroughly cooled; if it then breaks when bent, more linseed oil should be added so as to overcome the brittleness. I use this mixture when it is hot and apply when the tree is pruned. The grafting wax is superior to paint in the matter of healing. Paint prevents checking equally as well as wax and lasts much better. Paint also has the advantage of being much more convenient to apply.—Co-operative Farmer.

### Poultry Notes.

Have the nests ready when the hens begin to "cluck" and so secure more early chicks.

It is the early pullet that begins to lay before cold weather and keeps it up all winter. Don't fail to get them out if you wish to be successful in getting eggs next winter.

Kerosine the roosts well now and do not let the lice get the start of you this spring. They affect breeding hens as well as the setters. Look out for them.

Every man who grows chickens, and every man should grow more, will find that by introducing better blood he can improve the size and egg producing power of the flock. purchasing of eggs for hatching from some reliable breeder. A small investment in eggs will put any man in shape to grow a flock of pure bloods this year and reap the greater benefit sure to follow.

The breeding season is here. Now is the time to select your best females and put them with a good pure bred male and thus improve your young stock. It is a great mistake to think you can improve your stock with males not as good as your hens. Never breed from a mongrel or cross bred male. To breed poultry successfully we must breed for a purpose, and our aim should be to get more eggs and meat, hence more profits, and breeding from standard bred stock is the only way to get them quick. Stop inbreeding and "swapping" eggs with your neighbor because your hens do not lay. House, care and feed your stock well and you will see a great improvement.

If farmers would consume more poultry and less pork they would be healthier and live longer. There is no meat which compares with well-bred fresh poultry. Many make the mistake of sending all their luxuries to market. The same food that will produce a two-hundred pound hog will produce four hundred pounds of the best poultry meat and with one half the labor.—Co-operative Farmer.
