

Swift Canadian President Unable To Quote Figures

OTTAWA (CP) — The president of Swift Canadian Co. Ltd. told the Senate-Commons committee on living costs Tuesday he could not say what share of the meat-packing market Swift holds, nor how much it pays its parent American company for research and other services.

P. L. Ayers said he had brought none of the figures with him for the appearance of Swift before the committee in its investigation of food costs. The committee ordered the information to be submitted later.

Senator David Croll, committee co-chairman, asked for a special hearing, soon to allow a public cross-examination of the Swift officials on the figures.

New U.S. Bomber Proposed

WASHINGTON (AP) — Defence Secretary Robert S. McNamara has been presented with a U.S. Air Force proposal for an advanced manned strategic bomber to succeed the aging B-52 and the FB-111 planned for the early 1970s, defence department officials said.

Details were kept secret for security reasons, but the proposed craft, known as AMSA, would have approximately five times the nuclear capability and twice the range of the FB-111, it was reported.

A classified memorandum — one of a series in recent months — was forwarded to McNamara with a description of the plane and its envisioned role in nuclear warfare.

The proposed bomber, would have 2½ times the speed and about the same range as the B-52, mainstay of the current bomber force.

In response to queries about the proposal, the defence department issued a statement which said the memorandum was one of several sent by Air Force Secretary Harold Brown to McNamara in line with McNamara's request for a definition of what the AMSA should be.

"The New York Times story on the subject contains some facts and some fiction," the defence statement said. "For security reasons, we cannot discuss details of the air force study at this time."

IT'S A LONG, LONG TIME QUEBEC (CP) — Roger Molson, 29, a Quebec City (Smith) was sentenced to a total of 440 years in jail Monday, by sessions judge Albert Dumontier. Since the sentences will run concurrently, he will serve only 10 years in jail, however.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

South dealer. North-South vulnerable.

NORTH

- ♠ K74
- ♥ Q953
- ♦ J92
- ♣ Q75

EAST

- ♠ 8652
- ♥ 84
- ♦ A K J 8 6 4
- ♣ A 10 7 2

CONTRACT BRIDGE

The bidding: South West North East 1 ♠ 2 ♠ 2 ♠ 3 ♠

CONTRACT BRIDGE

Opening lead—nine of clubs. Let's say you're declarer with

the South hand at four hearts. West leads a club, which you duck, and East wins the trick with the jack. East next cashes the ace of clubs and shifts to a diamond.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

This is a disappointing development because, if East had led the third round of clubs, you would have been able to guarantee the contract by means of an elimination play.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

You would have ruffed the third club high, drawn two rounds of trumps, cashed the A-K of spades, ruffed a spade, entered dummy with a trump, and then finessed the jack of diamonds. West would win a diamond, but you would now have to lead a diamond or give you a ruff and discard.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

But when East leads the diamond at trick three, this method of play is no longer available. You know from the bidding, as well as from the size of the diamond led, that the four is a singleton, and that—if you finesse—West will win and return a diamond and you will go down one.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

You also know that if you go right up with the ace of diamonds, you will be left with two diamond losers and the same fate will threaten you.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

However, when you think further about the matter, you realize that there is a way out of your difficulties. You can still execute an endplay, though of a different sort.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

What you do is take the ace of diamonds, draw two rounds of trumps, cash the A-K of spades, ruff a spade, cross to dummy with a trump, and then lead the queen of clubs.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

When East covers with the king, you discard a diamond, deliberately losing a trick you could have won. This forces East to return a spade or a club; in either case, you make the contract, discarding your last diamond as dummy ruffs the return.
