WINNIPEG, June 19 - (CP) - Oats and barley brought aggressive buying by shippers and exporters today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Prices showed a firm tone most of the session, aided by advances on U.S. grain markets. Overseas accounts took barley. Trade reports said a cargo was sold to Norway and smaller amounts to the continent. American interests took oats and it was believed trade reached large proportions. Some industrial demand appeared in flax while rye was mixed trade. Overnight loadings of Canadian wheat for export were: Germany 350,000 bushels, Italy 370,000, United Kingdom 112,000, Belgium 700,000, Japan 350,000 and Israel 340,000.
