British Surcharges Effect In Canada Scaled Down

OTTAWA (CP)—It now appears that less than 25 per cent of Canada's exports to Britain will be affected by the new British import surcharge. The previous government estimate of 33 per cent was scaled down after a ruling in the detailed surcharge exemptions with Canadian exports to Britain in the January-August period. These exports totalled \$792,210,000. It now is estimated that the surcharge of 15 per cent would apply to approximately \$152,200,000 worth of these goods or roughly 23 per cent of the total.

These sales reached \$398,688,000 in the January-August period, up nearly 75 per cent from a year earlier.

The great majority of the Canadian metals shipped to Britain go in this unwrought form. If they are shaped or rolled into other forms, they will be subject to the surcharge. Similarly, rough-sawn lumber will be exempt but dressed lumber will be subject to the surcharge. Wood pulp will be exempt, but newsprint will be taxed. Almost all Canadian chemicals also will be subject to the surcharge.

The life insurance industry figures life insurance selling should be a career in itself. Mutual fund men feel a salesman with both commodities in his briefcase would be in the best interests of the public. The Canadian Mutual Funds Association is seeking dual-licensing—permission to sell both life insurance and mutual funds. Mutual funds are companies which sell shares to the public and invest the proceeds in shares of other firms with an eye to growth and capital gain.

In recent years the trade department has spent thousands of dollars to boost the sale of Canadian manufactured products in Britain. This investment was just beginning to produce dividends when the surcharge was announced.

The Life Underwriters Association of Canada says dual-licensing should not be permitted in Canada because it "would be contrary to the best interests of the public."

Canadian sales of such goods to the British market totalled \$3,533,000 in the first eight months of this year. While they were only about four per cent of all Canadian exports to Britain, they had risen 44 per cent from a year earlier.

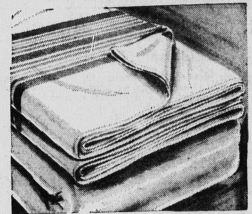
