HUGH JOHN MUCH PLEASED.

THOUSANDS WILL CHANGE THEIR VOTES AT THIS ELECTION.

Premier Macdonald has returned from his eastern tour. He expressed great satisfaction with the welcomes he received and with the prospects of the Conservative party in Ontario. "The tour," said Mr. Macdonald, "has been a very trying one, owing to the number of meetings arranged, but I have enjoyed it immensely. The cordial receptions given Sir Charles Tupper and Mr. Foster wherever we appeared argue well for the success of the conservative party in Ontario at least. They seem to be thoroughly organized, well prepared, and are certainly undivided in their allegiance to Sir Charles, whose manly vigor has infused fresh confidence into the party."

"There are thousands of Conservatives who voted Liberal in 1896 who will certainly vote Conservative now, and there are thousands of good Liberals perfectly sick of their leaders, especially of Tarte, Sifton, Blair and Laurier, whom they blame for abandoning the free trade policy of 1893 and 1896. There is a feeling that Sir Wilfrid deceived his party on his platform, especially on the tariff. There is a feeling that he is a time-server, whose promises are not to be depended upon."

"When will you begin the campaign in Brandon?"
"As soon as possible. There is a caucus tonight, I understand, and as soon after as arrangements can be made I will take the stump."
"When do you expect the elections?"
"It is impossible to say. I feel almost certain, however, they will be over before two months. We are ready at any time. Our party are doing little talking, but are quite prepared."

THE PREVAILING TASTE AT OTTAWA.

Mr. R. L. Richardson was ostracized at Ottawa and driven out of the Ministerial caucus because he had had the audacity to declare that the party platform should be observed, to insist upon an enquiry into the Yukon scandals, to oppose the railway robbery, and to vote against the serving of ground dog biscuit upon our soldiers as food.

a candidate in Lisgar against Mr. Richardson. So dreadful a man must not be permitted to darken the doors of Parliament again.

On the other hand, Mr. Bourassa opened a fierce anti-British campaign in Quebec on the "Why fight for England?" cry.

He at once became the party (whip in Parliament.

The Government has not put a man against him in his constituency for the purpose of excluding him from the House.

On the contrary, it is taking care of his political interests, and is touring him through Quebec, where he is telling the people to be cold towards Britain and the flag, to see that we help the Empire no more, and to vote for Liberal candidates who will support Laurier and Tarte through thick and thin.

The Ottawa Government has a taste peculiar to itself. It does not like R. L. Richardson and his principles, but Messrs Bourassa and Monet are all right.—Mail and Empire.
