## DOENITZ ENDS TERM

**BOHN (AP)**—Former Grand Admiral Karl Doenitz, Nazi Germany's last Fuehrer, will be released from Spandau prison on Oct. 1, Allied officials said Tuesday. Doenitz, 64, is one of the five top Nazi war criminals held under four-power control in the big Berlin prison. His 10-year sentence expires next month. He is said to plan to settle down in the South German state of Bavaria. Allied authorities said Doenitz is in poor health. Doenitz was named by Hitler as his successor just before the Third Reich collapsed.
