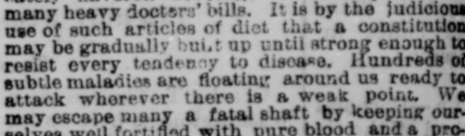

The following is a summary of railroad construction in the United States in the first nine months of 1890, showing that 3,782 miles of new road have already been built in thirty-nine states and on 212 different lines. The states showing the largest amount of new mileage are: Georgia, 323 miles; Montana, 312; North Carolina, 226; and Washington, 207. The only states and territories in which no track has been laid this year are New Hampshire, Vermont, Rhode Island, Connecticut, Delaware, New Mexico, North Dakota, Nevada and Utah. It is estimated that the total construction in 1890 will be from 6,000 to 6,500 miles against 5,200 reported in 1889.

Tornadoes have not hitherto been associated with our idea of the temperate heats of Europe. But that continent this year has witnessed several destructive ones, and even England has had a whirlwind which presents all the essential features of our American tornado. On the 21st ult. a tornado passed over East Stoke farm in Wareham, leaving extraordinary wreck along its fifty yard wide path. A part of the roof of a large cart shed was carried away, and a screen was drawn up the chimney out of a room in the farm house, and torn to pieces outside. If this kind of thing were likely to be frequent in England in future, it might be a wise precaution to screw all the furniture down on the floors to keep it from being sucked over to the fireplace and up the chimney. But the weather of the year has been of a most exceptional character over almost the whole world, and it may be a long time again before England has another meteorological sensation like that noted.
