

# World Bank Loans Support Projects In Many Countries

Announcements from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, commonly known as the World Bank, are a continuing story of constructive developments in many parts of the world.

Recent announcements from the bank and its affiliate, the International Development Association, some of which offer opportunities for Canadian supply or construction bidding, include the following:

Development credit equivalent to \$10,000,000 to Pakistan for the Khairpur ground water and canal irrigation project in the lower Indus Valley.

Credit equal to \$15,000,000 to India for the SONE irrigation system in West Bihar and another of \$10,000,000 for improvements at the port of Bombay.

A loan equivalent to \$30,000,000 for continuation of a national power expansion program in Yugoslavia.

AID MEXICAN POWER  
A loan equivalent to \$10,000,000 to Mexico for country-wide expansion of electric power facilities and another for \$20,000,000 for extension of the country's toll transport system.

The Pakistan project is intended to restore and protect the productivity of more than 300,000 acres of farmland now being driven out of production by increasing water-logging and salinity of the soil.

## Canadian Counter-Missile Faces Test Late This Year

OTTAWA (CP)—Canadian research into a counter-missile system will receive the acid test later this year in Pacific trials of the United States Army's Nike-Zeus.

The U.S. Army will not only attempt to intercept an Atlas intercontinental ballistic missile with the practice Nike-Zeus but will try to distinguish between the Atlas rocket and accompanying decoys.

Canadian laboratory experiments have been in the field of discrimination between rockets and decoys and other "space garbage" beyond saying that the Valcartier establishment has been doing work for the U.S. in this field.

Premier Khrushchev of Russia claimed in an interview made public Monday that the Soviet Union has a global rocket which can't be destroyed by "any anti-rocket means" but has anti-rocket missiles of its own which can "hit a fly in outer space."

**REACH AGREEMENT**  
HAMILTON, Ont. (CP)—Canadian Westinghouse Company Limited has announced an agreement with Merlin and Geris S. A. of France for the manufacture and sale in Canada of high-voltage air blast circuit breakers of advanced European design. The agreement permits manufacture for export to Commonwealth and most non-Commonwealth countries to which Westinghouse has been exporting, but excludes Common Market countries.

**SWEDISH STEEL**  
A planned increase of 60 per cent in Sweden's steel production to 3,500,000 tons would raise Sweden's steel production to 3,500,000 tons and perhaps 1,500,000.

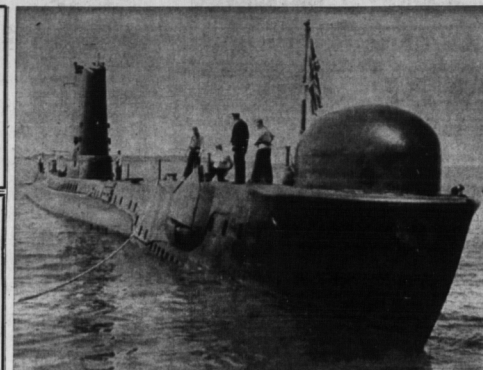
