## Alligator Can Be Dangerous

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. (AP)—The alligator, one of Florida's top tourist attractions, is suddenly under suspicion of being a man killer.

It has long been known that the lazy, repulsive-looking reptiles sometimes make unprovoked attacks on humans. Plenty of documented cases are on record but no clear-cut case of their killing a man has been established.

But a little more than a week ago a nine-year-old boy, Alan David Rice, disappeared from his home at Eau Gallie. Two days later his mangled body, with both arms missing, was found on the overgrown bank of a creek near his home.

Teeth marks on the body were clearly those of an alligator. Hunters killed an 11-foot specimen found nearby. Inside its stomach they found the boy's arms and other parts of his body.

Whether he had drowned before the alligator got to him could not be determined. One doctor said the alligator probably killed him; another said the evidence was not sufficient for inclusion.

**NUMBER OF ATTACKS**

Within a 25-year period a number of persons have been attacked and injured by alligators in Florida. In 1948 Martha Belle Smith suffered a broken left arm and a lacerated right hand at Weekiwahee Springs in an encounter with an alligator called "ol' nine-toes."

Alligators under six feet are considered harmless to man but the big fellows are due all the respect given any other large, wild animal.

The males grow to 16 feet. They have powerful jaws and sharp teeth suitable for gripping and holding. When they seize a large victim, they twist and roll in the water to tear it to pieces.

The big reptiles inhabit Florida's swamps in uncounted thousands.

## Little Change Expected In Overseas Commitments

 OTTAWA (CP)—Little change in Canada's overseas commitments is foreseen under the new Progressive Conservative regime.

Observers say, indeed, that these commitments may be extended by offering of economic aid to new and emerging independent Commonwealth nations.

The general feeling here is that if there are major changes in this country's commitments abroad—such as a withdrawal of troops from Europe—they would not result from the change in government here so much as a shift in the international situation.

In his Dominion Day speech in London, Prime Minister Diefenbaker expressed strong support for the Colombo Plan. Canada has contributed \$162,000,000 to this plan for economic development in South and Southeast Asia since its inception in 1950.

**TO HELP OTHERS**

Mr. Diefenbaker said it is his government's intention "to lend a helping hand, if we can, to some other countries as they enter the portals of independent and responsible government within the Commonwealth."

"The Canadian government is taking immediate steps to send a high commissioner to Accra (capital of Ghana, new Commonwealth member) and one of his first assignments will be to explore needs and possibilities in the field of technical assistance."

Other overseas areas where Canada has commitments are Europe, the Middle East, Indonesia, Korea and Kashmir.

It is considered unlikely here that Canada will reduce its NATO forces in France and West Germany—a 6,000-man infantry brigade group and 300-plane air division of jet fighters—for at least 18 months. That would be about the time that West Germany would have assumed its full share of western European defence.

**MORE ECONOMICAL**

It now is cheaper to keep the Canadian forces in Europe. If they were brought home, new camps, airfields and housing would have to be provided for them.

Mr. Diefenbaker has already indicated Canada will maintain its 1,200-man contribution to the United Nations Emergency Force in Egypt.
