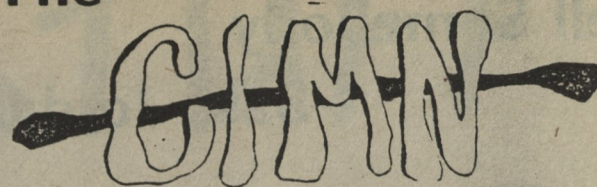
A Poem for My Secret Love

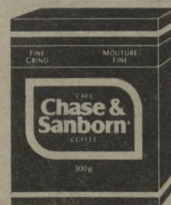
