In continuing spades since it seemed very likely declarer would immediately establish with at least nine tricks. So he switched to the device of ducking the ace of spades. South played low. West won with the eight and returned the three to East's king. There was no recovery for South. He wound up losing three clubs, a spade, and a diamond for down one.

Opening lead-eight of spades. The defenders have to think harder than the declarer in most deals because they must see each other's hands and there are no aids to help them. The declarer, on the other hand, seeing dummy's cards and his own, is in much better position to gauge his prospects, assess his strong and weak points, and take advantage of knowledge he possesses that the opponents do not.

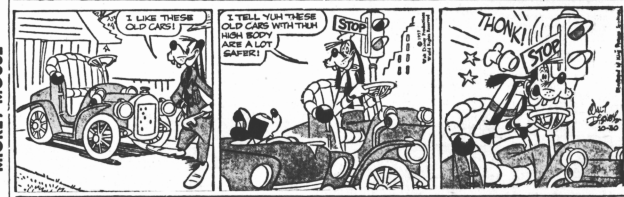
