WINNIPEG, July 14 - (CP) - Coarse grains futures prices on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today showed a lower trend after early advances. Trading was influenced by declines on U.S. markets. Commercial demand was less aggressive. Some buying in barley was attributed to routine shipping orders and routine shipping orders appeared in oats. Early trade also showed some seaboard support in flax. Export trade in Canadian coarse grain appeared quiet.

Week-end loadings of Canadian wheat for export were: United Kingdom 880,000 bushels, South Africa 180,000, Netherlands, 330,000, Germany 160,000, Bolivia 115,000, and Belgium 30,000.

Prices of class two wheat were up 1/4 cent. Prices of I.W.A. wheat were down 1/4 cent.
