TONSILS SHOULD NOT BE REMOVED JUST BEFORE THE FOLIO SEASON

As parents read health articles written by reputable physicians, they naturally cannot understand how one physician or group of physicians will make a statement which is flatly contradicted by another group of equal standing.

Thus in the Year Book of Pediatrics (children's diseases) of 1950, we read the statement that 'taken objectively, the facts do not prove that tonsillectomy predisposes to poliomyelitis.'

As a sort of 'clincher' of the fact that this paralyzing type of polio shows more of the bulbar type after recent removal of tonsils, the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis, which distributes the hundreds of thousands of dollars annually collected to prevent polio of all types, has accepted the fact that removal of tonsils and adenoids should not be done just prior to the polio season.
