

LEADERSHIP AWARDS

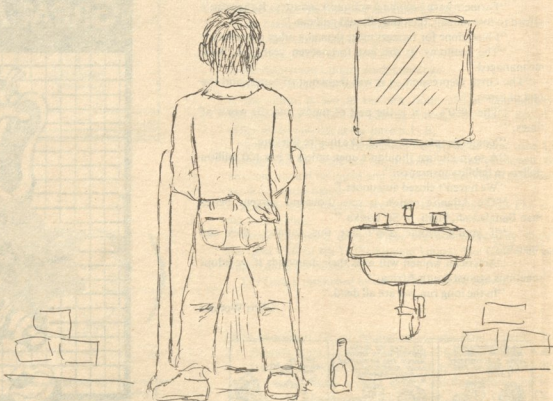
