information pamphlets (graduate studies, research postings, etc.)

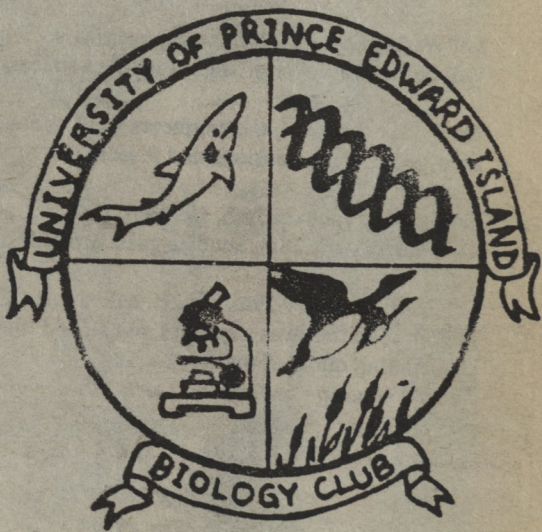
