Untouchables Join Buddhism

BOMBAY, India (AP)—Nearly 250,000 Hindu untouchables embraced Buddhism at the city of Nagpur Sunday in what was described as the biggest mass religious conversion in history. The converts are followers of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar, a former of India's constitution and its first law minister after independence. He and his wife, also a doctor and born into Hinduism's highest caste, the Brahmins, became Buddhists several years ago. Almost since India became independent in 1947 Ambedkar has been campaigning for untouchables to leave the Hindu fold and become Buddhists because of what he calls Hindu "oppression and inequality." He was born an untouchable and for many years was shunned socially despite his Western education and his prominence as a political leader. By ancient Hindu custom, untouchables are by birth without any caste — literally outside human society.

Israel Signs Contract With Canadian Firm For 24 Jets

OTTAWA (CP)—The Israeli government has signed a contract with Canadair Ltd. of Montreal for the purchase of 24 Sabre jet fighter planes, it was learned Thursday. The total price is around 7,200,000, including spare parts.
Prime Minister St. Laurent announced Sept. 21 that the cabinet had approved sale of the Canadian jets to Israel, which had made the request in April.
The prime minister said the government's decision was "greatly influenced" by the fact that Egypt has received "large numbers" of jet fighters from Russia and, "even more important, a considerable number of modern jet bombers, of which Israel possesses none."
Evidently the government has not regarded the recent border clashes between Israel and Jordan as sufficient cause to hold up delivery of the Sabres.
Israel will pay about the same price for the Sabres—\$300,000 each—that the Canadian government itself pays to equip the 12 squadrons of Sabres in the RCAF air division in Europe.
