

Summer Arrangements for Travel.

Trains leave Charlottetown for the West at 6 a. m., 8.45 a. m., and 3.30 p. m. (standard time) daily.

The steamer Heather Belle plies between Charlottetown and Belfast on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of each week; on each Friday between Charlottetown and Cranberry Wharf, going on alternate Fridays to Mount Stewart; and on each Saturday between Crapaud and Charlottetown.

The Rocky Point sail boat plies as follows: Monday and Thursday.—Leave Rocky Point for Charlottetown at 8 and 10 a. m., and at 12.30, 3 and 5 p. m.; Leave Charlottetown for Rocky Point at 9 and 11 a. m. and at 2, 4, and 6 p. m.

NEILL'S Express leaves Charlottetown for Belfast every morning (Sunday excepted), at 7 o'clock, calling at the Post Office on the route.

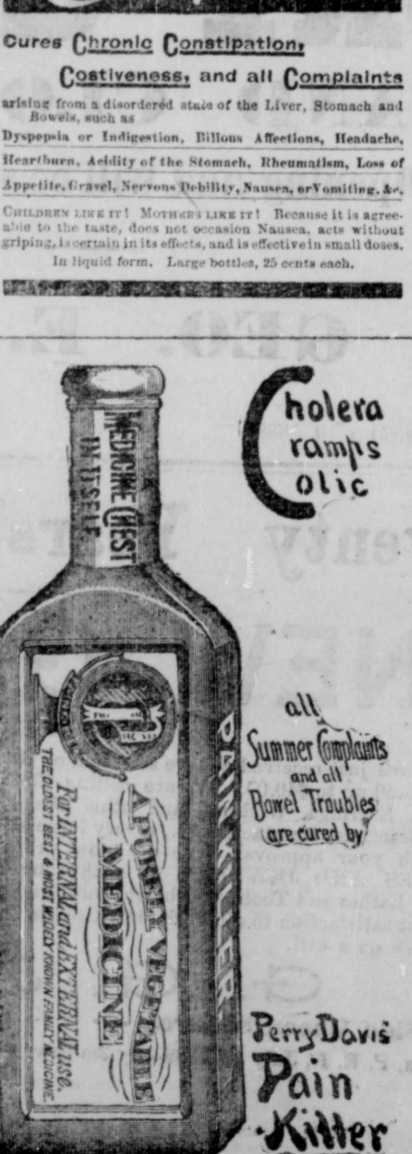

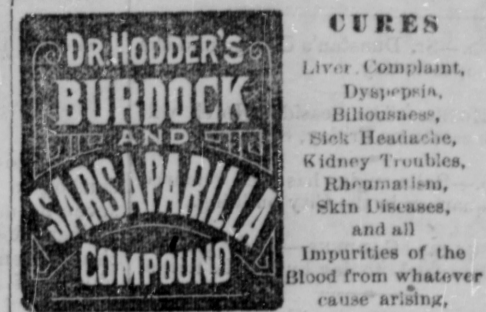
