COLONIAL DAIRY PRODUCTS IN ENGLAND.

Dairy products from the British colonies are becoming an important feature in the English market. The first imports of this kind were of Australian cheese in 1887, when 13,100 pounds were brought in. In 1893 this amount had increased to more than 3,500,000 pounds. The trade in butter is increasing still more. During the season from 1893, to June, 1894, there were landed at London 492,222 packages of butter, of which 373,576 were Australian and 118,646 New Zealand, compared with 184,910 Australian and 62,957 New Zealand in 1893, and 229,999 and 55,436 packages respectively in 1892.
