

# Algerian Discontents Get Blunt Treatment

ALGIERS (Reuters)—A French government representative warned Algeria's discontented Europeans to "shut up or go" Wednesday as the territory celebrated the first anniversary of the revolt that swept President Charles de Gaulle to power.

The speech by French Delegate-General Paul Delouvrier was regarded here as amounting to an official declaration of war against de Gaulle's hard-core European opponents. It was seen as a sign that the president considers he had enough support for his Algerian policy from both Moslems and Europeans here to resist extremist pressure.

The extremist minority, "activists" who were in the vanguard of the army-settler takeover a year ago Wednesday, boycotted the holiday celebrations and observed a "day of mourning."

They charged de Gaulle's policies may lead Algeria to self-determination and away from their goal which is the closest possible integration with metropolitan France.

Delouvrier, named to his job by de Gaulle in December, spoke to 50,000 persons at a rally outside the main government building. Telling the crowd not to become nervous because France's battle with Algerian Moslem nationalist rebels has been going on for 4½ years, the delegate-general said:

"Let the impatient, the incredulous, the dividers, shut up or go. They play the game of the adversary."

Two-thirds of the crowd were Moslems. Delouvrier urged them to make their voice heard more strongly in politics.

## Trawler Row Raised Again

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP)—Transport Minister Hees says trawlers designed like the ill-fated Blue Wave are suitable for use in the northwest Atlantic. The Blue Wave sank off southeastern Newfoundland in February with the loss of 17 men.

A letter from Mr. Hees was released recently by Fisheries Minister J. T. Cheeseman of Newfoundland. It replied to criticism by a Newfoundland member of the legislature who said Blue Wave-type vessels are unsuitable for use on the Grand Banks.

"... It appears that the immediate cause of the capsizing was an excessive buildup of ice on deck which resulted in a fatal loss in stability before the master and crew were fully aware of the situation," Mr. Hees' letter said.

"We are satisfied that trawlers with design and specifications similar to those of the Blue Wave are quite suitable for operation under winter conditions in northwest Atlantic waters, provided that they are loaded with due regard to the weather conditions, and are competently handled."

The 289-ton Blue Wave was 143 feet long and had a beam of 25 feet. She was built in 1950.

## Univ. Program Said Planned
