The bidding:

South West North East
1♥ 2♣ 2♦ Pass

Opening lead—king of clubs. There is much more to this play of some hands than meets the eye. For example, take this deal which featured exceptionally good play by both sides.

West led the king of clubs, and, seeing dummy's threatening diamonds, shifted to a low spade at trick two. His hope was to find partner with something like the K-Q-x or K-J-10 of spades, in which case the defense could quickly grab three spades to defeat the contract one trick.

But East could do no better than produce the ten of spades, which lost to the king, and South started to draw trumps. On the third trump, West,

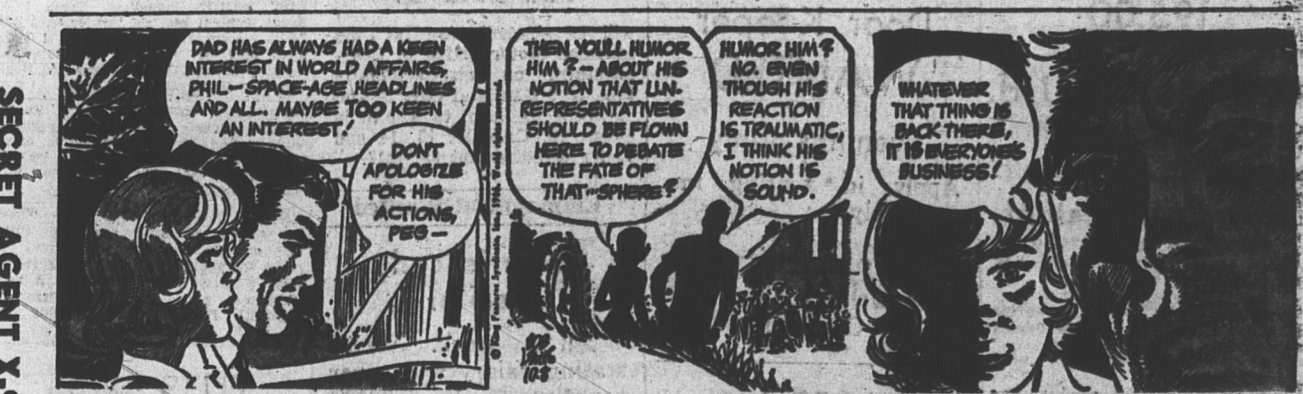
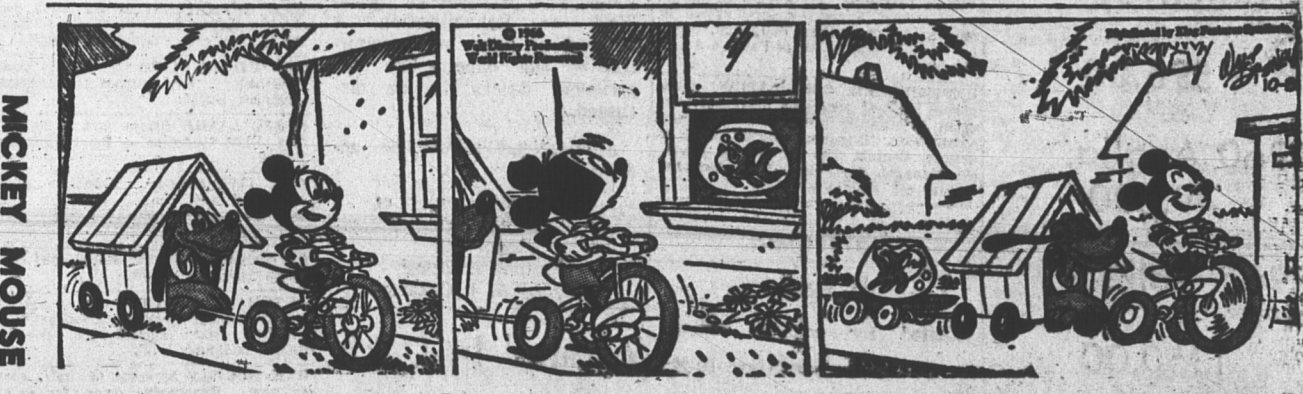
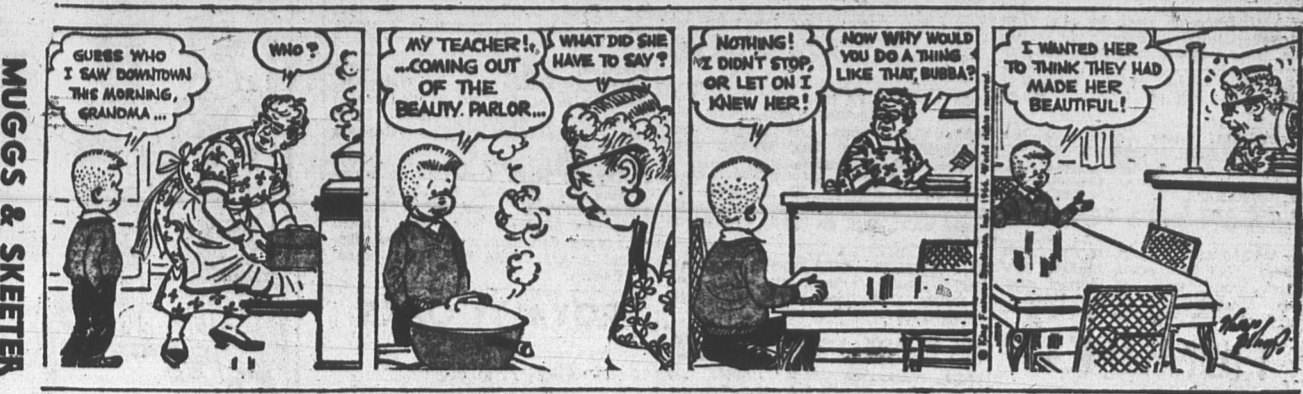
